Dear Valued Customer,

Title II of the Drug Quality and Security Act, Drug Supply Chain Security Act requires that beginning July 1, 2015, “*dispensers*” must capture transaction information, transaction history, and transaction statements, as necessary to investigate a suspect product, and maintain such information, history, and statements for not less than 6 years after the transaction.

HCI has been providing you with the required Drug Quality Security Act documentation for each prescription drug shipped to your facility. The Advanced Shipment Notification (ASN) contains not only required information, but also additional information such as the lot numbers and expiration date for each product shipped. This document accompanies the order shipment and is also available direct to your designated email.

As an integral partner in the pharmaceutical supply chain we created a useful tool and repository for your record requirements in an electronic format. Our goal is to provide you an opportunity to utilize our proprietary services to maintain and store your data retention requirements. With this advanced technology, you are not only compliant since January 1, 2015 for all products from HCI, but well beyond the November 2017 requirement of electronic records.
